nothers and Sisters, it is the saints who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, obtained promises, shut the mouths of lions, quenched raging fire, escaped the edge of the sword, won strength out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. Women received their dead by resurrection. Others were tortured, refusing to accept release, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned to death, they were sawn in two, they were killed by the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, perse-



cuted, tormented— of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, and in caves and holes in the ground. Yet all these, though they were commended for their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had provided something better so that they would not, apart from us, be made perfect.

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.

Did you know that we are on the doorstep of one of the Church's fasts?

Every year on the Monday after All Saints Sunday we begin the Apostle's Fast. It lasts till June 29th. Since the date of Easter varies from year to year, the length of the fast also varies.

How should we observe this fasting period?

Well, there are no particular rules set out by the current synod of Bishops for this particular fast. We should at minimum continue to observe the usual "No meat on Friday" rule, and if we are able consider expanding this to

Wednesdays and perhaps even Mondays. In the "olden days" we typically would not have any festivities such as marriages or parties of any sort. But today, fasting rules have been relaxed for the faithful to nothing more than the ordinary. My recommendation: Be healthy with your diet. Refrain from sin of course. Also from excess "noise" such as TV, computer games and pointless surfing, cell phones apps that aren't productive, and other unnecessary uses of time that take away from our ability to pray and spend time with our loved ones.

Last Week we forgot to include a "Congratulations", so here it is... one week late.



Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to Church, to God and to Christ. Let them know that they are at home in this sacred space.




