- Investment Income includes interest and dividends earned from the Parish Operating, CROSS, Local Charity and Gaming Accounts per Schedule 2.
- 2018 Unrealized Loss on Investments result from the market values of our investments at December 31, 2018 – See Note 4. The North American markets at December 31, 2018 were at yearly low levels, and the reason for the unrealized loss. The markets (as at March 24, 2019) however have since recovered and we have recovered most of the recorded unrealized loss.
- Parish Investments are sound with low risk investments that are expected to do better in 2019.
