



Medical Mercy Canada (MMC) is one of the charities that is supported by the St. Stephen International Charities Trust Fund.

MMC has been providing both financial and medical aid to Ukraine since 1992. Supplies are distributed by MMC designated on-site managers to medical clinics, hospitals, and long-term care facilities. Financial aid has been instrumental in the growth and development of schools. MMC has been helping the people of Ukraine to create their own healthy communities.

MMC also lends a helping hand in the form of renovation projects within facilities such as orphanages, childcare centers, geriatric centers, remote health clinics, and rural schools. They improve their quality of life by improving their standard of living.

Since the conflict in Ukraine began, support has been given to the Ukrainian people through financial aid and medical supply deliveries.

The MMC country managers have shifted their focus from pre-conflict projects to the current crisis. They have been coordinating medical supply deliveries and supporting the many displaced people who have made it to western Ukraine. A portion of funding previously designated toward infrastructure projects has been redirected to provide immediate aid to camps and villages.

ODESA OBLAST – Humanitarian Aid near Odesa & neighboring Oblasts

The destruction of the Kakhova Dam caused extensive flooding in the south and southeast of Ukraine. The clean water shortage has become more widespread and severe.

MMC assisted by providing drinking water to those in need.

MMC started a campaign to provide simple portable water filtration units to communities in need. MMC plans to purchase the filtration units and send them to the areas most in need.

The filter units are small and can be transported in a car. They do not need electricity to operate so are ideal for communities that have had their power, as well as their water supply, destroyed.
