Scholarship Awards for 2022

The Calgary Ukrainian Cultural Foundation annually recognizes those persons whose efforts and commitment enrich the Calgary Ukrainian community. Awards are open to Calgary youth 16 to 24 years of age planning to attend post high school educational or apprenticeship training programs. The course of study is not a criterion for selection.

The Calgary Ukrainian Cultural Foundation will award four \$500 scholarships annually.

Guidelines are as follows:

1. Applications must be submitted by ~~October 24, 2022~~. Extended to November 15, 2022.
2. Calgary or past Calgary resident with Ukrainian heritage.
3. High School Graduate minimum requirement.
4. Applications will be scored and awarded by the Calgary Ukrainian Cultural Scholarship Executive Committee.
5. Preference will be given to first time applicants. Applicants who have received a Calgary Ukrainian Cultural Foundation Scholarship in prior years will only be considered if not all four scholarships have been awarded for the current year.

Application form to be completed and the following attached:

1. Transcripts from High School, recent studies, or previous training programs (if available).
2. Letter of acceptance from accredited institution.
3. Two reference letters to be sent by the writer directly to the address below.
4. Personal letter of intent regarding educational / career aspirations and contributions to the Calgary Ukrainian community.

All the documents above must be attached to the application or received by CUCF prior to ~~October 24, 2022~~. Extended to November 15, 2022. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Conditions of scholarship awards:

1. Names of all award winners will be made public.
2. Awards will be presented mid-November, location to be advised.
