THIRD SUNDAY OF THE GREAT FAST

VENERATION OF THE HOLY CROSS,
OUR VENERABLE FATHER GERASIMUS OF THE JORDAN (475)

At the 8:30 Liturgy – A silent procession is made with the Holy Cross from the Altar to the tetrapod. The priest incenses the four sides of the tetrapod while the faithful sing the following troparion:

Troparion (tone 1):

Save Your people, O Lord, and bless Your inheritance.* Grant victory to Your faithful people against enemies,* and protect Your community by Your cross. (x3)

Then, standing before the Holy Cross, the priest intones:

To Your Cross, O Master, we bow in veneration* and we glorify Your Holy Resurrection. (prostration)

The Liturgy then continues with "Blessed is the Kingdom..."

Troparia and Kontakia

Troparion: Angelic powers were upon Your tomb* and the guards became like dead men;* Mary stood before Your tomb* seeking Your most pure body.* You captured Hades without being overcome by it.* You met the Virgin and granted life.* O Lord, risen from the dead,* glory be to You!

Troparion: Save Your people, O Lord, and bless Your inheritance.* Grant victory to Your faithful people against enemies,* and protect Your community by Your cross.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kontakion,: No longer does the flaming sword guard the gate of Eden;* the tree of the Cross has quenched its flames gloriously.* The sting of death and the victory of Hades are banished,*

and You O my Saviour came and called to those in Hades: "Return again to Paradise!"

Instead of Holy God, we sing:

To Your Cross, O Master,* we bow in veneration,* and we glorify Your holy Resurrection!(x3)

Epistle

Hebrews 4:14-5:6

A reading from the Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Hebrews.

Brothers and Sisters, since, then, we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast to our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Every high priest chosen from among mortals is put in charge of things pertaining to God on their behalf, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He is able to deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is subject to weakness; and because of this he must offer sacrifice for his own sins as well as for those of the people. And one does not presume to take this honor, but takes it only when called by God, just as Aaron was.
