## SECOND SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

MARTYR LUCILLIANUS AND THOSE WITH HIM

APOSTLE'S FAST

***Troparia and Kontakia***

*Troparion:* Though the stone was sealed by the Judeans,\* and soldiers guarded Your most pure body,\* You arose, O Saviour, on the third day,\* and gave life to the world.\* And so the heavenly powers cried out to You, O Giver of Life:\* Glory to Your resurrection, O Christ!\* Glory to Your kingdom!\* Glory to Your saving plan,\* O only Lover of mankind.

*Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.*

*Kontakion:* You arose in glory from the tomb\* and with Yourself You raise the world.\* All humanity acclaims You as God.\* and death has vanished.\* Adam exults, O Master,\* and Eve, redeemed from bondage now, cries out for joy:\* "You are the One, O Christ, Who offer resurrection to all."

*Now and for ever and ever. Amen.*

*Theotokion:* When Gabriel uttered to you, O Virgin, his 'Rejoice!\*' at that sound the Master of all became flesh in you, the Holy Ark.\* As the just David said,\* you have become wider than the heavens carrying your Creator.\* Glory to Him Who dwelt in you!\* Glory to Him Who came forth from you!\* Glory to Him Who freed us through birth from you!

***Prokeimenon***

Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, as we have hoped in You.

*verse:* Rejoice in the Lord, O you just; praise befits the righteous.

***Epistle***

*(Romans 2:10-16)*

*A reading from the Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Romans.*

Brothers and Sisters, there will be glory and honor and peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek. For God shows no partiality.

All who have sinned apart from the law will also perish apart from the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law. For it is not the hearers of the law who are righteous in God's sight, but the doers of the law who will be justified. When Gentiles, who do not possess the law, do instinctively what the law requires, these, though not having the law, are a law to themselves. They show that what the law requires is written on their hearts, to which their own conscience also bears witness; and their conflicting thoughts will accuse or perhaps excuse them on the day when, according to my gospel, God, through Jesus Christ, will judge the secret thoughts of all.

***Alleluia:*** God gives me vindication, and has subdued people under me.

*verse:* Making great the salvation of the king, and showing mercy to His anointed, to David, and to His posterity forever.

***Gospel***

*(Matthew 4:18-23)*

At that time, as Jesus walked by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fish for people." Immediately they left their nets and followed him. As he went from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John, in the boat with their father Zebedee, mending their nets, and he called them. Immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed him.

Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and curing every disease and every sickness among the people.

## Intro to the Apostles

**Andrew (the First Called)** – fisherman from Capernaum and disciple of John the Baptist before he joined with Jesus (John 1:35-40). He brought his brother Simon to Jesus.

**Peter (Simon Peter)** – also a fisherman. Introduced to Jesus by his younger brother Andrew. Renamed Cephas (in Greek, Peter, meaning “rock”) by Jesus as the rock upon which the Church will be built.

**James the Greater (son of Zebedee)** – fisherman and older brother of John. Often mentioned being present with John and Peter at special moments of Jesus’ ministry. “The Greater” as he was older than James “the Lesser.”

**John the Beloved** – fisherman, younger brother of James the Greater. Known for his youth and energy. Author of the Gospel of John and the three Letters of John.

**Philip** – yet another fisherman, from the city of Bethsaida (John 1:44). He seemed to have a missionary heart. Introduced Nathanael (also known as Bartholomew) to Jesus.

**James the Lesser (son of Alphaeus)** – Go figure, yet another fisherman and “brother” of Jesus (cousin or possibly step-brother). Considered to be the author of the Epistle of James. Also the first Bishop of Jerusalem.

**Judas Thaddeus (also known as Jude)** – brother of James the Lesser and the author of the book of Jude. Very little is known about him although he is the patron saint of lost causes.

**Bartholomew (Nathanael)** – praised by Jesus as being a Jew without guile (John 1:47). Though he was cautious in accepting Jesus as the Messiah he becomes a great missionary of Christ.

**Matthew (also known as Levi)** – Former tax collector who, like the others, dropped everything to follow Jesus. He wrote the first book of the New Testament which bears his name.

**Simon the Zealot** – the “other” Simon (besides Peter). Don’t know much about his origins other than to note that he was a member of a Jewish nationalist group known as the Zealots who despised Roman rule.

**Thomas** – also known by the Greek name Didymus (meaning “the twin”). Also known as Doubting Thomas because of his demand for physical proof of Jesus’ resurrection.

**Judas Iscariot** – the only Apostle from Judea (the others were from Galilee). The group’s treasurer who apparently liked to dip his hand into the purse. Betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver.
