Troparia and Kontakia

Troparion: You came down from on high, O Merciful One,* and accepted three days of burial* to free us from our sufferings.* O Lord, our life and our resurrection,* glory be to You!

Troparion: Clothed as in purple and fine linen* with the blood of Your martyrs throughout the world,* Your Church cries out to You through them, O Christ God:* send down Your loving-kindness on Your people;* grant peace to Your community,* and to our souls great mercy.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kontakion: O Lord, Master of nature,* the world offers You the godly martyrs as the first-fruits of nature.* By their supplications, through the Mother of God,* preserve Your Church and Your people in profound peace,* O most merciful One.

Prokeimenon: Pray and give thanks to the Lord our God.

verse: In Judea God is known;* His name is great in Israel.

Epistle: A reading from the Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Hebrews.

Brothers and Sisters, the saints who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, obtained promises, shut the mouths of lions, quenched raging fire, escaped the edge of the sword, won strength out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. Women received their dead by resurrection. Others were tortured, refusing to accept release, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned to death, they were sawn in two, they were killed by the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, persecuted, tormented— of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, and in caves and holes in the ground.

Yet all these, though they were commended for their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had provided something better so that they would not, apart from us, be made perfect.

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 11:33-12:2)

Alleluia: The just cried out and the Lord heard them,* and delivered them out of their afflictions. *verse:* The afflictions of the just are many,* and out of them all will the Lord deliver them.

Gospel: Matthew 10:32-33, 37-38; 19:27-30

The Lord said to his disciples, "Everyone who acknowledges me before others, I also will acknowledge before my Father in heaven; but whoever denies me before others, I also will deny before my Father in heaven.

"Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me.

Then Peter said in reply, "Look, we have left everything and followed you. What then will we have?" Jesus said to them, "Truly I tell you, at the renewal of all things, when the Son of Man is seated on the throne of his glory, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or fields, for my name's sake, will receive a hundredfold, and will inherit eternal life. But many who are first will be last, and the last will be first."

Second verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you just;* praise befits the righteous.* Alleluia (x3)





June 20, 2020 will mark the 100th anniversary of the end of the 1914-1920 National Internment Operations in Canada.

This is a very tragic but important part of our Ukrainian Canadian history that involves the violation of human rights and should never be forgotten.

Ukrainian Canadian Congress — Alberta Provincial Council will commemorate from June 1 - 19 the end of Internment Operations in Canada by hosting online daily segments to honour the internees and help inform our wider community of this very important period in Canadian history.

Prevent the Spread of Coronavirus

You are not permitted to enter church if...

- You have a dry cough, sore throat, fever, shortness of breath, or feel extremely tired
- You did not register previously for a public service or church service
- You do not provide contact information for emergency purposes

Please Practice Physical Distancing...


- Stay 2 meters (6.56 feet) away from others
- Avoid overcrowding common areas
- Follow advice of ushers in regards to maintaining social distancing
- Wash hands after touching communal surfaces
- No coffee socials or socializing after all public services
- Consider wearing PPE including non-medical masks and disposable gloves

You are legally required to self-isolate for:

- 14 days if you returned from international travel or are a close contact of a person with COVID-19
- 10 days if you have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat that is not related to a pre-existing condition

You MUST REGISTER with the <u>Parish Office</u> before attending a Liturgy

You can register in one of three ways:

- By signing up online through our website, bulletin or facebook links: https://bit.ly/2MA4VX5
- By sending an email to office@protomartyr.ca
- By calling the Parish Office at 403-249-4818, ext 0
- Be ready to provide the full name(s) of those attending and their contact information for attendance confirmation and emergency purposes (phone number and email address)
- Please register no later than Thursday preceding the Sunday you hope to attend. Consider attending every other week or even once a month to allow space for others.
- You will receive a confirmation email or phone call to verify your attendance
- The Province of Alberta has mandated that no more than 50 persons gather in our church at any one time. Please note that we will be limiting Liturgy attendance to 40 persons plus Priest/Cantor/Ushers/Cleaners. If you would like to volunteer as an Usher/Cleaner please contact the Parish Office (403-249-4818, ext 0)
- Please plan to arrive 30 minutes early to complete the required check-in process.
