Epistle

Hebrews 13:7-16

Brothers and sisters, remember those who rule

over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of *their* conduct. Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever. Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For *it is* good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.

We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. 

COVID-19



Alberta is now in Stage 3 of the Open for Summer Plan, effective July 1st. All public health measures have been lifted except in specific settings.

- Although the number of faithful is not restricted within the church we are easing into opening up completely over the summer months. Every second pew will be open for the month of July and, God willing, we will be able to open up completely for the month of August and onward. The choir will continue with cantors until after summer.
- Registration for services is no longer required.
- With respect to face masks we must follow Mayor Nenshi's Calgary restrictions, which may be different that the Provincial plan. Most recent... "On June 21, 2021 Calgary City Council voted to extend the municipal bylaw in the short term but will revisit the COVID-19 outlook again on July 5, 2021 to determine whether the bylaw will be repealed". Therefore face masks are required until July 5, and we will wait until the City gives their approvals after that. We look forward to congregational singing once the Calgary restrictions are lifted! When the restrictions are completely lifted face masks and hand sanitizer will be available in the church, but not mandatory.
- Single use spoons for Holy Communion distribution will continue until further notice.


WE NEED YOUR HELP! Sandwich / Snack Sunday


