


Epistle—Acts 11:19-26, 29-30

Gospel-John 4:5-42

At that time, Jesus came to a city of Samaria which is called Sychar, near the plot of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph. Now Jacob's well was there. Him who sent Me, and to finish His work. Do you Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give Me a drink." For His disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.

Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?" For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans. Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water."

The woman said to Him, "Sir, You have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do You get that living water? Are You greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well, and drank from it himself, as well as his sons and his livestock?"

Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

The woman said to Him, "Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw."

Jesus said to her, "Go, call your husband, and come here." The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband,' for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband; in that you spoke truly." The woman said to Him, "Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet. Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, and you Jews say that in Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship."

Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father. You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

this be the Christ?" Then they went out of the city and came to Him.

In the meantime His disciples urged Him, saying, "Rabbi, eat."

Ask Fr. Mike:

What is the Difference between Mortal and Venial Sins?

Запитайте О. Михайла: Яка різниця між Смертним і Легким гріхом?

If anyone sees his brother committing what is not a mortal sin, he will ask, and God will give him life for those whose sin is not mortal. There is sin which is mortal; I do not say that one is to pray for that. All wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin which is not mortal. (1 John 5:16-17)

St. John the Theologian teaches that although all wrongdoing is sin, there are sins of various seriousness or gravity. Some sins are serious enough to "kill love in our hearts" and therefore are referred to as mortal sins. Sins which weaken, but do not kill love, are called venial sins. For a sin to be mortal, three conditions must be met:

The object of the sin (the thing you do) must be grave.

It must be committed with full knowledge.

You must deliberately consent.

Grave sins correspond to the Ten Commandments and are ordered specifically by Jesus to the Rich Young Man (Mark 10:19) and their gravity depends on the order given (murder is worse than theft) and who is affected (violence against parents is worse than against strangers). A short and unexhaustive list of grave matters include:

Idolatry, Divination, magic and sorcery, Disrespecting the

Name of God or Holy Things, sacrilege

Deliberate failure of Sunday and Feast Day obligation Euthanasia, Suicide, drug abuse, gluttony, alcohol abuse, extreme anger, hatred

Adultery, fornication, pornography use, any sexual acts outside of marriage

Theft, cheating, bribery, defrauding a worker of his wages, lying, adulation (encouraging others in sin), false witness and perjury.

For example, someone choosing not to attend Divine Liturgy on a Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation (if they are well enough to attend) is a sin against God Himself, done with full knowledge and consent and therefore a mortal sin. If a sin involves grave matter but is not done with full knowledge or consent it remains a venial sin.

If you are aware of a mortal sin on your heart you should confess before approaching for Holy Communion. If you are unsure, I encourage you to refrain for now and come and chat with me. Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky encouraged his flock to confess monthly at a minimum. Remember, brothers and sisters, my goal here is not to condemn, but to help form your conscience and encourage you to participate worthily in the Most Holv Eucharist. God loves you and knows your sins better than you know them and wants to forgive all your sins!

Св. Іоанн Богослов навчає, що хоча всі злочини є гріхами, існують гріхи різної серьозності та тяжкості. Деякі гріхи настільки серйозні, що «вбивають любов у наших серцях», і тому їх називають смертними гріхами. Гріхи, які не вбивають любов, називаються легкими гріхами. Є три умови, які визначають, чи є гріх смертним:

- 1) Обьект гріха(те що ви робите) має бути серйозним.
- 2) Здійснено з повним усвідомленням.
- 3) Ви свідомо погоджуєтися зі зробленим.

Тяжкі гріши відповідають Десяти Заповідям, які надані Ісусом через Мудрого Молодого Чоловіка(Марк 10:19), і їхня тяжкість залежить від наказу(вбивство гірше за крадіжку) і від того, хто постраждав(насильство проти батьків гірше, ніж проти незнайомців).

Короткий і неповний перелік тяжких гріхів включає:

Ідолопоклонство, ворожіння, магія та чаклунство, неповага до Імені Бога чи Святих речей, святотатство, навмисне недотримання обовьязків у Неділю та Святкові Дні.

Евтаназія, самогубство, вживання наркотиків, обжерливість, зловживання алкоголем, злість, ненавість.

Подружня зрада, блуд, перегляд порнографії, будь-які сексуальні відношення поза шлюбом.

Крадіжка, шахрайство, хабарництво, виманювання зарплати працівників, брехня, лестощі (спонукання інших до гріха), лжесвіжчення.

Наприклад, хтось вирішує не відвідувати Божествену Літургію у Неділю або у Святковий день(якщо він достатньо здоровий, щоб бути присутнім) є гріхом проти Самого Бога, вчинений свідомо, це і є смертний гріх. Якщо гріх повязаний із серйозною справою, але вчинений не усвідомленням чи згодою, він залишається легким гріхом.

Якщо ви маєте сумнів, закликаю вас поки що утриматися від участі у Святому Причасті та поспілкуватися зі мною. Митрополіт Андрій Шептицький закликав своїх прихожан сповідатися принаймні щомісяця.

Памятайте, брати та сестри, моя мета не засуджувати, а допомогти подолати ваше сумління та заохотити вас гідно брати участь у Пресвятій Євхавристії. Бог любить вас і знає ваші гріхи краще за вас і хоче пробачити всі ваші гріхи!

1 The Church has grown in her understanding of depression as a medical condition and so suicide is not necessarily a mortal sin. We continue to trust in the Lord's mercy in this situation. However, recourse to MAiD is premediated (planned) and therefore the levels of knowledge and consent are raised.
