

Angelo Accepting to Become a Missionary

ANGELO ZIDAN'S STORY

"Growing up, I was the typical Christian boy who would serve in the altar on Sundays but my relationship with God was nothing more than me holding a candle. I never understood the true meaning of what Jesus had done for me and never had experienced God's full and unconditional love. I understood God as someone who was in the sky and in order to receive any kind of love from him, I would have to live a perfect life, one with no sin and never fail, or else bad things would happen to me.

As I got older, I started to fall away from the church and I reached a point in my life where I was lost. I remember walking up and down the halls of Mount Royal University where all the school clubs were and asking God "I want to join something that will help

me make more friends but also help me get closer to you." All of a sudden I walked up to a random table, at least I thought it was random, God had led me to Catholic Christian Outreach. I signed up for the first faith study and since then I've continued to grow in faith and in friendship.

In April 2019 I made the conscious decision to invite Jesus into the centre of my life and started living my life within the Catholic Church. I continue to grow in my faith every day."

Angelo recently graduated with a Business degree from Mount Royal University. He likes participating in sports and activities where he can build relationships with his peers. Angelo also attended several activities with St. Stephen's Youth group.

You might not know Angelo, **yet**, but you would know his parents Samer and Skia Zidan. You might see them volunteering at St Stephen's events, attending 8:30 Liturgy, or during our monthly UCWLC meetings where Skia is the Treasurer.

Angelo's journey will continue with Catholic Christian Outreach where he will be attending the University of Saskatchewan working as a fulltime missionary. His goal is to bring young people back to the Catholic Church, to evangelize.
